A BILL FOR

An Act to authorize the purchase and condemnation of certain property in the city of Des Moines, Iowa, for the use of the Iowa liquor control commission and to provide an appropriation therefor.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. That the executive council of the state of
 2 Iowa is hereby authorized to direct the attorney general to
 3 commence condemnation proceedings in the name of the state of
 4 Iowa for the condemnation and purchase of the property described
 5 as the west seventy (70) feet of lots one (1) and two (2),
 6 Block G, Griffith's Addition in the city of Des Moines, Iowa,
 7 which property is now rented by the state of Iowa under a lease
 8 for a period commencing October 1, 1946, and ending September
 9 30, 1966.

1 Sec. 2. That said property is to be condemned and
 2 purchased for the use of the Iowa liquor control commission in
 3 constructing a warehouse or other facilities necessary for the
 4 purposes of the Iowa liquor control commission.

1 Sec. 3. That there is hereby appropriated out of the
 2 liquor control act fund of the state of Iowa, not otherwise

3 appropriated, a sum not to exceed thirty thousand dollars
4 (\$30,000.00) to be used by the executive council of the state
5 of Iowa in condemnation and purchasing in the name of the state
6 of Iowa the following described real estate:

7 The west seventy (70) feet of lots one (1) and
8 two (2), block G, Griffith's Addition in the
9 city of Des Moines, Iowa,

10 said sum of money is to be paid unto the Hubbell Company upon
11 the completion of the condemnation proceedings and the
12 establishment of the title in the state of Iowa as is
13 provided by law and requisition for a warrant shall be drawn
14 against said appropriation by the executive council.

1 Sec. 4. This act being deemed of immediate importance
2 shall be in full force and effect from and after its
3 publication in the,
4 a newspaper published at, Iowa,
5 and in the, a newspaper
6 published at, Iowa.

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 411

This act provides for the purchase of property adjacent to the International Harvester Company building, which the state owns and which is going to be used by the state liquor control commission. It is necessary that the liquor control commission have additional trackage and storage facilities, and furthermore it is essential that the property be purchased in order to complete the state's building program.
