A BILL FOR

An Act to authorize the purchase of real property in the city
 of Des Moines for the use of the Iowa liquor control
 commission and to provide an appropriation therefor.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. That the executive council of the state of
 2 Iowa be and is hereby authorized to purchase from the city of
 3 Des Moines, Iowa, the alley eighteen (18) feet in width and
 4 three hundred sixty (360) feet long which lies east of lots
 5 one (1) to six (6) inclusive in block G, Griffith's Addition
 6 in the city of Des Moines, Iowa, for a sum not to exceed two
 7 thousand dollars (\$2,000.00).

1 Sec. 2. That there is appropriated out of the liquor
 2 control act fund of the state of Iowa, not otherwise
 3 appropriated, a sum not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00)
 4 to be used by the executive council of the state of Iowa in
 5 making purchase in the name of the state of Iowa of the
 6 following described real estate:

7 The alley eighteen (18) feet in width and three
 8 hundred sixty (360) feet long which lies east of

9 lots one (1) to six (6) inclusive in block G,
10 Griffith's Addition in the city of Des Moines, Iowa.
11 which sum of money is to be paid unto the city of Des Moines,
12 Iowa, on conveyance by said city of Des Moines, Iowa, of the
13 above described real estate by warranty deed and the furnishing
14 of an abstract of title to the state of Iowa showing said
15 property to be free and clear of all liens and incumbrances
16 and requisition for a warrant shall be drawn against said
17 appropriation by the executive council.

1 Sec. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance
2 shall be in full force and effect from and after its
3 publication in the,
4 a newspaper published at, Iowa, and
5 in the, a newspaper published
6 at, Iowa.

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 412

This act provides for the purchase of property adjacent to the International Harvester Company building, which the state owns and which is going to be used by the state liquor control commission. It is necessary that the liquor control commission have additional trackage and storage facilities, and furthermore it is essential that the property be purchased in order to complete the state's building program.
