A BILL FOR

An Act to amend chapter one hundred thirty-one (131), Acts of the Fifty-first General Assembly, relating to the appropriation for handicapped children.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Chapter one hundred thirty-one (131), section
2 twelve (12), Acts of the Fifty-first General Assembly is hereby
3 amended by striking from line five (5) and line six (6) the
4 words and figures "three hundred ninety-three point three
5 (393.3)" and substituting in lieu thereof the following words
6 and figures: "three hundred twenty-nine point three (329.3)".

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 428

This bill is to correct an obvious discrepancy in the chapter numbers referred to in the original law. Chapter three hundred twenty-nine point three (329.3) relates to the three point tax system, not three hundred ninety-three point three (393.3) as printed in the bill.

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 429

The purpose of this bill is to make it possible for a grantor and a life tenant, in cases where contingent remaindermen cannot be determined, to have property sold under proper proceedings, and the proceeds held intact under the jurisdiction of the court until the remaindermen are determined.
