A BILL FOR

An Act to provide for an emergency appropriation for the state superintendent of public instruction, Iowa school lunch division, to permit the Iowa school lunch program to function during the remainder of the biennium.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the state
 2 superintendent of public instruction, Iowa school lunch division,
 3 the state not otherwise appropriated, the sum of eleven
 4 thousand eight hundred sixty dollars (\$11,860.00) to permit
 5 the Iowa school lunch program to function for the period from
 6 March 16, 1947, to June 30, 1947 and to be used for the
 7 following purposes:

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 501

The federal government provided for the appropriation of money to carry on free hot school lunches for the public schools in all states. It also provided that the states must set up their own administration and pay the costs of such out of their own state funds. Inasmuch as this was set up after the last legislature had adjourned, there was no appropriation made to take care of the administration of this act so it was necessary for the retrenchment and reform committee to appropriate some money to carry on this work, but they only provided part of the money, figuring that the Fifty-second General Assembly should make an appropriation to carry them out to the end of the fiscal year, ending June 30, 1947. Therefore this is being recommended to carry on that work for that period of time.
