A BILL FOR

An Act to legalize proceedings of the board of supervisors of Worth County, Iowa, with respect to payment of a claim of the Northwood Fire Co. in the sum of \$165.52 arising from damage to fire truck on July 20, 1946.

WHEREAS, the board of supervisors of Worth County, Iowa did pay from their general fund the sum of \$165.52 which was the cost of repairing the fire truck owned by the Northwood Fire Co.; and

WHEREAS, doubts have arisen concerning the legality or validity of said proceedings and it is deemed advisable to put said doubts at rest; now, therefore,

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. All proceedings of the board of supervisors
2 of Worth County, Iowa, with respect to payment of the claim of
3 the Northwood Fire Co. in the sum of \$165.52 arising from damage
4 to fire truck on July 20, 1946, are hereby legalized and
5 validated.

1 Sec. 2. This act being deemed of immediate importance,

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 503

On July 20, 1946, one of the trucks of the Northwood Fire Company, in response to a fire call, struck a depression in a county road created by the settling of soil in a newly filled tile ditch that had been recently cut through the roadbed. The condition had not been noticed and no warning signs were posted to notify approaching vehicles of the condition of the roadbed.

The accident caused a repair expense to the Northwood Fire Company of \$165.52 and the board of supervisors reimbursed the fire company.
