A BILL FOR

An Act to enable the City of Waterloo, Iowa to increase the salaries of all non-elective city employees Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per month for the period commencing April 1, 1947, and ending March 31, 1948, by transfer of money from the City Sewage Disposal fund to various city funds; and by authorizing the City of Waterloo, Iowa, to raise its total estimated budget expenditure and appropriations for said period in the sum of Twenty-six Thousand Four Hundred Forty (\$26,440.00) Dollars.

WHEREAS, the cost of living has risen in the City of Waterloo, Iowa, since August, 1946, when the city council prepared the estimated budget for the period from April 1, 1947, to March 31, 1948, and the city council of said City believes that an increase of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per month should be granted all non-elective city employees, and

WHEREAS, the budget of the City of Waterloo, Iowa, for the period commencing April 1, 1947, and ending March 31, 1948, will have to be increased in the sum of Twenty-six Thousand Four Hundred Forty (\$26,440.00) Dollars if the city employees are to be granted this increase, and

WHEREAS, this sum is available and can be transferred from the sewage disposal fund of the City of Waterloo, Iowa, on a temporary transfer to the other various city funds to be repaid the following year, and

WHEREAS, it would be for the best interests of the city, its citizens and employees to grant this increase;

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. That the City of Waterloo, Iowa is hereby
- 2 authorized to increase its budget expenditures and its

3 appropriations for the period commencing April 1, 1947, and
4 ending March 31, 1948, in the amount of Twenty-six Thousand
5 Four Hundred Forty (\$26,440.00) Dollars for the purpose of
6 raising the salaries of all non-elective city employees
7 Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per month.

1 Sec. 2. The City of Waterloo, Iowa, is further
2 authorized to transfer the sum of Twenty-six Thousand Four
3 Hundred Forty (\$26,440) Dollars from its sewage disposal
4 fund to other various city funds to accomplish this purpose,
5 said transfer to be repaid in the following year.

1 Sec. 3. This Act being deemed of immediate
2 importance shall take effect and be in force from and after
3 its publication in the Waterloo Daily Courier, a newspaper
4 published in the city of Waterloo, Iowa, and the Cedar Falls Daily
5 Record, a newspaper published in Cedar Falls, Iowa, all
6 without expense to the State.

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 512

This bill is designed to enable the City Council of Waterloo, Iowa, to transfer money from the City Sewage Disposal fund to various other funds so that increases in pay may be made to all city employees who are NOT elective officers.
