A BILL FOR

An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state to the cosmetology examiners for operating deficiency to June 30, 1947.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the
 2 general fund of the state to the cosmetology examiners for
 3 the period ending June 30, 1947, the sum of two thousand
 4 twenty-five dollars and twenty-four cents (\$2,025.24) or so
 5 much thereof as may be necessary for operating deficits to-wit:

6 For salaries, support, maintenance
 7 and miscellaneous purposes.....\$2,025.24
