## **HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION**

Providing for the acquisition of a home for the Governor of the State of Iowa, the appointment of a committee in relation thereto, and prescribing its powers and providing for an appropriation for that purpose.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the funds  
2 received or to be received on interest-bearing securities  
3 held by the state treasury, the sum of fifty thousand dollars  
4 (\$50,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to  
5 provide a home for the governor of the state of Iowa, at the  
6 seat of government.

1 Sec. 2. The funds herein appropriated or as much thereof  
2 as may be necessary shall be used by the executive council  
3 of the state, together with three members of the Senate to  
4 be appointed by the President of the Senate, and three  
5 members of the House to be appointed by the Speaker of the  
6 House, who shall act as a joint committee, the majority of  
7 this committee shall acquire, remodel, furnish and equip a  
8 suitable and adequate property; or a majority of this  
9 committee may acquire real estate and provide architectural

10 services, erect, furnish and equip a suitable and adequate  
11 home from such funds as provided herein or as much thereof  
12 as may be necessary.

1 Sec. 3. The committee is hereby authorized and  
2 empowered to carry on all negotiations to acquire a  
3 governor's home and to enter into any and all contracts  
4 necessary to be made and to bind the state of Iowa in all  
5 matters pertaining to the purposes of this Resolution, and  
6 a majority of said committee is hereby vested with these  
7 powers. Requisition for warrants shall be drawn against  
8 said appropriation by the Secretary of the executive  
9 council upon direction by a majority of said committee.

1 Sec. 4. This Resolution being deemed of immediate  
2 importance shall be in full force and effect from and  
3 after its publication in the Lockridge Times, a newspaper  
4 published at Lockridge, Iowa, and in the Durant News, a  
5 newspaper published at Durant, Iowa.
