## A BILL FOR

An Act to amend chapter one hundred forty-seven (147), Code 1946, relating to the refund of license fees paid by persons who served with the armed forces of the United States during World War II, and who were honorably discharged therefrom.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Chapter one hundred forty-seven (147),  
2 Code 1946, is hereby amended by inserting as a new  
3 section thereof the following:  
4 "Any license fee imposed under the provisions  
5 of this chapter, and paid by a person who, during the  
6 entire period for which said license fee was imposed,  
7 has served in the armed forces of the United States  
8 during World War II and who has been honorably dis-  
9 charged therefrom, shall be refunded to said person,  
10 provided application therefor, supported by his af-  
11 fidavit and a certified copy of his discharge  
12 certificate showing period of service in accordance  
13 with said application, is made by such person. Where  
14 the application involves fees paid for a license to  
15 practice pharmacy the application shall be made to

16 the secretary of the board of pharmacy examiners,  
17 and where it involves fees paid for a license to  
18 practice nursing the application shall be made to  
19 the secretary of the board of nurse examiners. In  
20 all other cases the application shall be made to  
21 the state department of health. Upon approval  
22 thereof, and a certification of the amount of refund  
23 due thereunder, either by the commissioner of public  
24 health, or by the secretary of the board of pharmacy  
25 or nurse examiners, as the case may be, to the state  
26 comptroller, the said comptroller shall pay said  
27 amount due from the general fund, and there is hereby  
28 appropriated annually out of the general fund not  
29 otherwise appropriated such amounts as may be necessary  
30 to pay said refunds. No license fees paid prior to  
31 the effective date of this Act shall be refunded unless  
32 application therefor is filed with said department  
33 prior to July 1, 1948, and no license fees paid  
34 subsequent to the effective date of this Act shall  
35 be refunded unless application therefor be filed with  
36 said department within six (6) months after the date  
37 of the honorable discharge of said applicant. No  
38 additional fees paid in connection with the renewal  
39 of a license to practice pharmacy, under the provisions  
40 of section one hundred forty-seven point one hundred  
41 (147.100), or in connection with the renewal of a

42 license to practice embalming, under the provisions of  
43 section one hundred forty-seven point one hundred one  
44 (147.101), shall be refunded under the provisions  
45 hereof”.
