A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section two hundred seventy-four point forty (274.40), Code 1946, relating to the reorganization of school districts and the adjustment of boundary lines of school districts when lands are returned to private ownership after having been acquisitioned by the federal government.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section two hundred seventy-four point
2 forty (274.40), Code 1946, is hereby amended by adding thereto
3 the following: "Whenever real estate acquired by the United
4 States government as provided in section two hundred seventy-
5 four point thirty-nine (274.39), Code 1946, is returned to
6 private ownership through sale or otherwise the County Board
7 of Education of such county in which such land is located
8 shall have authority to adjust the boundary lines of contig-
9 uous school districts in such manner as they may deem just
10 and equitable so as to include and make said real estate
11 a part of the school districts to which the land is contiguous,
12 or to reorganize said real estate into a separate school
13 district as provided by law; provided, however, that said
14 real estate shall revert to and again become a part of the

15 school district from which it was taken if such district
16 still exists as a school district.”

1 Sec. 2. This act being deemed of immediate importance
2 shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage
3 and publication in the Plain Talk, a newspaper published at
4 Des Moines, Iowa, and the Burlington Hawk-Eye Gazette, a
5 newspaper published at Burlington, Iowa.
