A BILL FOR

An Act to repeal section six hundred six point fifteen (606.15), code 1946, and to enact a substitute therefor relating to the fees to be charged by the clerk of the district court and to provide for the payment of a flat fee in certain cases.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section six hundred six point fifteen (606.15), Code
2 1946, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in lieu
3 thereof:

1 Section 1. In all actions at law or in equity,
2 including actions of partition, actions to quiet title
3 and actions for the foreclosure of mortgages or liens,
4 appeals or writs of error, actions of mandamus, certiorari,
5 and all special proceedings not otherwise specified in this
6 act and in proceedings for adoption in the district court,
7 there shall be paid to the clerk of the district court
8 by the plaintiff or petitioner a filing fee of ten dollars,
9 which fee shall be in lieu of all fees, except those here-
10 inafter provided.

11 In addition to, or in lieu of the filing fee, as
12 the case may be, the clerk shall collect from the party

13 seeking or requiring the service and pay into the county
14 treasury the following fees:

15 1. For each writ or injunction or attachment other
16 than the first and for each writ of general execution,
17 one dollar.

18 2. For each special execution, one dollar and fifty
19 cents for issuance and one dollar and fifty cents
20 for recording.

21 3. For filing and properly entering and indorsing
22 each mechanic's lien, one dollar and fifty cents,
23 the same to be taxed as costs in any suit brought
24 thereon.

25 4. For certificate and seal, except to applications
26 to procure pensions, bounties, or back pay for
27 soldiers or other persons entitled thereto, seventy-
28 five cents.

29 5. For filing and docketing transcript or judgment
30 from another county or justice of the peace or
31 municipal court, not in connection with an appeal
32 therefrom, one dollar and fifty cents.

33 6. For issuing a commission to take depositions,
34 one dollar.

35 7. For entering judgment by confession without
36 action, one dollar and fifty cents.

37 8. For all copies of records or papers filed in
38 his office and for making complete records in cases

39 where the same is required by law or directed by an
40 order of the court and for making out transcripts
41 in criminal cases appealed to the supreme court, fifty
42 cents per legal size page of double space typing, or
43 any fraction thereof.

44 9. For taking and approving a bond or sureties
45 thereon, fifty cents.

46 10. For issuing marriage licenses, three dollars.

47 11. For all services performed in the settlement
48 of the estate of any decedent, minor, insane person,
49 or other persons laboring under any legal disability,
50 except where actions are brought by the administrator,
51 guardian, trustee, or person acting in a representative
52 capacity or against him, or as may be otherwise provided
53 herein, where the value of the property of the estate
54 does not exceed three thousand dollars, three dollars;
55 where such value is between three thousand dollars
56 and five thousand dollars, five dollars; where such
57 value is between five thousand dollars and seven
58 thousand dollars, eight dollars; where such value
59 is between seven thousand dollars and ten thousand
60 dollars, ten dollars; where such value is between
61 ten thousand dollars and twenty-five thousand dollars,
62 fifteen dollars; for each additional twenty-five
63 thousand dollars or major fraction thereof, there
64 shall be taxed the further sum of ten dollars.
