## **A BILL FOR**

An Act to legalize and validate the proceedings authorizing and providing for the issuance, sale and delivery of park bonds by the city of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, and the provisions made for taxes for the payment of said bonds and declaring said bonds issued pursuant to said proceedings to be enforceable obligations of said city.

WHEREAS, the city council of the city of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, did heretofore by resolution adopted on January 27, 1946, authorize and provide for the issuance and delivery of park bonds of said city in the principal amount of \$60,000 for the purpose of permanently improving lands theretofore acquired for park purposes in and for said city and by said resolution provided for the payment of the interest on and principal of said bonds by the levy and collection of annual taxes on all the taxable property in said city; and

WHEREAS, doubts have arisen concerning the validity and legal sufficiency of said bonds and proceedings and the provisions made for the payment of same, and it is deemed advisable to put said doubts and all others that might arise concerning same forever at rest;

NOW, THEREFORE,

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. That all proceedings heretofore taken by
- 2 the city council of the city of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, authorizing
- 3 and providing for the issuance, sale and delivery of park
- 4 bonds by the city of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, and providing for
- 5 the levy and collection of annual taxes to pay the interest on

6 and principal of said bonds, are hereby legalized, validated  
7 and confirmed, and said park bonds issued, sold and delivered  
8 pursuant to and in accordance with said proceedings are hereby  
9 declared to be legal and to constitute valid and binding  
10 obligations of said city.

1     Sec. 2. This act being deemed of immediate importance  
2 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication  
3 in the ....., a newspaper published in the city
