A BILL FOR

An Act to amend chapter three hundred twenty-one (321), Code 1946, relating to extension and renewal of motor vehicle operators licenses and fees therefor.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Amend section three hundred twenty-one point
2 one hundred ninety six, (321.196), Code 1946, by striking the
3 contents thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
4 "The Department shall extend every operators license numbered
5 five hundred thousand and no hundredths, (500,000) and above
6 expiring July 5, 1948 for a period not to exceed the next
7 birthday of the licensee and shall extend every operators
8 license numbered from one (1) to five hundred thousand and
9 no hundredths (500,000) expiring July 5, 1948 to July 5, 1949
10 and, in addition thereto, for a period not to exceed the next
11 birthday of the licensee; provided, however, all licenses
12 numbered from one (1) to five hundred thousand and no hundredths
13 (500,000) upon application for renewal shall pay, in addition
14 to the regular license fee, an additional fifty per cent (50%)
15 thereof to cover the period from July 5, 1948 until their next
16 birthday following July 5, 1949. Persons whose birthday occurs

17 on February 29th shall be deemed to occur on March 1, for the
18 purpose of this act. All operators licenses renewed after
19 July 5, 1948, shall expire each two years from the licensee's
20 date of birth. All applicants for renewal of operators
21 licenses made after July 5, 1948, shall be made under
22 the direct supervision of a member of the Iowa Highway
23 Patrol and shall be approved by a member of said Patrol.
24 The Commissioner may, in his discretion, authorize
25 the renewal of a valid license upon application with-
26 out an examination provided that, a person holding such
27 license has no conviction of a traffic violation during
28 the previous two years and, provided that such person
29 satisfactorily passes a vision test as prescribed by
30 the Department.
