A BILL FOR

An Act to amend Chapter one hundred sixty-six (166), Code 1946, relating to the manufacture, sale and use of Hog Cholera Virus and Serum, by amending section one hundred sixty-six point one (166.1), section one hundred sixty-six point three, (166.3), section one hundred sixty-six point six (166.6), section one hundred sixty-six point ten (166.10), and section one hundred sixty-six point thirteen (166.13), Code 1946, by repealing section one hundred sixty-six point sixteen (166.16), Code 1946, by amending section one hundred sixty-six point seventeen (166.17), and section one hundred sixty-six point eighteen (166.18), Code 1946, by repealing section one hundred sixty-six point nineteen (166.19) to section one hundred sixty-six point twenty-six (166.26) inclusive, Code 1946, by amending section one hundred sixty-six point twenty-seven (166.27), Code 1946, by repealing section one hundred sixty-six point twenty-eight (166.28) and section one hundred sixty-six point thirty (166.30) to section one hundred sixty-six point thirty-three (166.33) inclusive, Code 1946, relating to Hog Cholera Virus and Serum and the manufacture, sale and use of such products.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 "Section 1. Sections one hundred sixty-six point sixteen
 2 (166.16), one hundred sixty-six point nineteen (166.19), one hundred
 3 sixty-six point twelve (166.20), one hundred sixty-six point twenty-
 4 one (166.21), one hundred sixty-six point twenty-two (166.22), one
 5 hundred sixty-six point twenty-three (166.23), one hundred sixty-six
 6 point twenty-four (166.24), one hundred sixty-six point twenty-five

7 (166.25), one hundred sixty-six point twenty-six (166.26), one
8 hundred sixty-six point twenty-eight (166.28), one hundred sixty-
9 six point thirty (166.30), one hundred sixty-six point thirty-one
10 (166.31), one hundred sixty-six point thirty-two (166.32), one
11 hundred sixty-six point thirty-three (166.33), of Chapter one hundred
12 sixty-six (166), Code 1946, are hereby repealed.

1 “Sec. 2. Section one hundred sixty-six point one (166.1), Code
2 1946, is amended by adding the following sub-section:

3 “4. ‘Place of business’, is construed to mean each place or
4 premises where biological products are stored or kept for the
5 purpose of sale, dispensation or distribution, or where biological
6 products are offered for sale, dispensation or distribution.’

1 “Sec. 3. Section one hundred sixty-six point three (166.3),
2 Code 1946, is amended by striking the period (.) at the end of said
3 section in line five (5) and adding the following: ‘and shall be
4 required to have a separate permit for each place of business.’

1 “Sec. 4. Section one hundred sixty-six point six (166.6),
2 Code 1946, is amended by striking the words ‘a bond’ in line three
3 (3) and substituting in lieu thereof the following: ‘a separate
4 bond for each place of business’; and further amend said section by
5 striking the word ‘five’ in line four (4) and substituting in lieu
6 thereof the word ‘one’; and further amend said section by inserting
7 after the word ‘dollars’ in line five (5) the following: ‘for each
8 place of business.’

1 “Sec. 5. Section one hundred sixty-six point ten (166.10), sub-
2 section two (2), Code 1946, is amended by striking from line eight

3 (8) of said section the words 'fifteen dollars' and by substituting
4 in lieu thereof the following: 'one dollar for each place of
5 business or'.

1 "Sec. 6. Section one hundred sixty-six point thirteen (166.13),
2 sub-section one (1), Code 1946, is amended by striking the period (.)
3 in line five (5) and by adding to said sub-section the following:
4 ', or by his failure to obtain a separate permit and to file a
5 separate bond in the sum of one thousand dollars for each place of
6 business.'

1 "Sec. 7. Section one hundred sixty-six point seventeen (166.17)
2 Code 1946, is amended by striking from lines three (3) and four (4)
3 the words, 'the holder of a permit issued by the department for that
4 purpose' and substituting in lieu thereof the words 'a farmer or
5 land owner vaccinating his own hogs.'

1 "Sec. 8. Section one hundred sixty-six point eighteen (166.18),
2 Code 1946, is amended by striking all after the period (.) following
3 the word 'virus' in line five (5) of said section and substituting
4 in lieu thereof the following: 'Whenever, fifteen (15) or more
5 applicants in any county request the County Extension Director for
6 such a school of instruction, he shall, in writing, notify the
7 extension division of the state college of agriculture and mechanic
8 arts, which division shall arrange for such a school of instruction
9 within thirty (30) days after such notification and shall furnish a
10 competent instructor, such school to be held at the time and place
11 as is designated by the County Extension Director and such school
12 shall be free and open to all interested persons. These schools of

13 instruction shall, when reasonably possible consist, at least in
14 part, of actual vaccinating demonstrations and shall be completed in
15 one day or less.

1 “Sec. 9. Section one hundred sixty-six point twenty-seven (166.27)
2 Code 1946, is amended by adding to said section the following:
3 ‘Schools of instruction held at said college shall be conducted
4 substantially in the same manner as county schools.’”
