A BILL FOR

An Act to authorize county Boards of Supervisors in counties having a city having a population of one hundred twenty-five thousand (125,000) or more, or cities having a population of one hundred twenty-five thousand (125,000) or more, or such counties and cities by united action, to appropriate money for information centers for returned veterans.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Any county in which there is a city having
2 a population of one hundred twenty-five thousand (125,000)
3 or more, or any city having a population of one hundred
4 twenty-five thousand (125,000) or more, or any such above
5 described county and city by united action, may expend and
6 appropriate at the discretion of the city council of such
7 city or Board of Supervisors of such county, or both, such
8 sums as are necessary to pay the costs and expenses of
9 continuing and maintaining information centers for returned
10 veterans.

1 Sec. 2. This act shall terminate on April 1, 1949.

1 Sec. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance
