## **A BILL FOR**

An Act to legalize and validate the proceedings authorizing and providing for the payment of certain expenditures made by the City of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, for improvements at the site of temporary homes for veterans of World War II and declaring said proceedings to be enforceable obligations of said city.

— WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, did heretofore by resolution authorize and provide for the improvement of a site for the location of temporary housing facilities for veterans of World War II, said improvements consisting of water main, sewer, lights and roadways; the amount of said expenditures being \$12,000 and said expenditure being made in connection with a Federal Public Housing Project for veterans of World War II; and

WHEREAS, doubt has arisen concerning the validity and legal sufficiency of said resolution and the provisions made for the payment of said improvements, and it is deemed advisable to put certain doubts and all others that might arise concerning same forever at rest; now, therefore,

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. That all proceedings heretofore taken  
2 by the City Council of the City of Cedar Rapids, Iowa,  
3 authorizing and providing for the payment of certain improvements  
4 in connection with the establishment of temporary homes  
5 for veterans of World War II are hereby legalized, validated  
6 and confirmed and said obligations are hereby declared to

7 be legal and to constitute valid and binding obligations of  
8 said City.

1     **Sec. 2.** This act being deemed of immediate  
2 importance shall take effect and be in full force from and  
3 after its publication in the Cedar Rapids Gazette, a  
4 newspaper published in the City of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, and  
5 in the Marion Sentinel, a newspaper published in  
6 Marion, Iowa, all without expense to the  
7 state.
