## A BILL FOR

An Act to amend Chapters one hundred thirty-five (135) and one-hundred thirty-seven (137), Code 1946, to provide for the reporting of all cases of epilepsy to the State Department of Public Safety by all physicians, local boards of health, health officers and the State Department of Health.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Amend Chapter one-hundred thirty-seven (137),  
2 Code 1946, by adding thereto the following: Local boards of  
3 health, and health officers, shall report immediately in writing  
4 to the State Department of Health, the name, age and address  
5 of every person reported to them as a case of epilepsy.

1 Sec. 2. Amend Chapter one-hundred thirty-five (135), Code  
2 1946, by adding thereto the following: (1) The State Department  
3 of Health shall define epilepsy for the purpose of the reports  
4 hereinafter referred to. (2) All physicians shall report  
5 immediately to the local health officer in writing the name, age  
6 and address of every person diagnosed as a case of epilepsy, or  
7 similar disorders, characterized by lapse of consciousness. (3)  
8 The local health officer shall report in writing to the State  
9 Department of Health the name, age and address of every person

10 reported to him as a case of epilepsy. (4) The State Department  
11 of Health shall report to the Department of Public Safety the  
12 names, ages and addresses of all persons reported to it as cases  
13 of epilepsy by physicans and local health officers. (5) Such  
14 reports shall be for the information of the Department of Public  
15 Safety in enforcing the provisions of Chapter three-hundred  
16 twenty-one (321), Code 1946, and shall be kept confidential and  
17 used solely for the purpose of determining the eligibility of  
18 any person to operate a motor vehicle on the highways of this  
19 state.
