## **A BILL FOR**

An Act to make appropriations to Christine M. Mitchell, Reinbeck, Iowa; Alfred Wrieden, Fort Madison, Iowa; Page County, Clarinda, Iowa; Grant Shade, Des Moines, Iowa; J. A. Strand and Ruth Andersen Strand, Dayton, Iowa; Tri City Delivery Service, Davenport, Iowa; Mrs. Clara B. Noble, Des Moines, Iowa; Muscatine County, Muscatine, Iowa; Robert P. Bell, Cedar Rapids, Iowa; Harold W. Miller, Clarinda, Iowa.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the  
2 general fund of the State of Iowa to Christine M. Mitchell,  
3 Reinbeck, Iowa, the sum of one thousand two hundred ninety-  
4 five and 72/100 dollars (\$1295.72) in full settlement of all  
5 claims she may have against the State of Iowa for personal in-  
6 juries as a result of an accident at Eldora Training School  
7 while claimant was employed there.

1 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated out of the  
2 general fund of the State of Iowa to Alfred Wrieden, Fort  
3 Madison, Iowa, the sum of four hundred dollars (\$400.00) in  
4 full settlement of all claims he may have against the State  
5 of Iowa for personal injuries arising out of fall from cell-  
6 house while washing windows at State Penitentiary.

1     Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated out of the  
2     general fund of the State of Iowa to Page County, Clarinda,  
3     Iowa, the sum of four thousand two hundred ninety-four and  
4     55/100 dollars (\$4294.55) in full settlement of all claims  
5     it may have against the State of Iowa for erroneous pay-  
6     ment of care and keep of Frank Fetty and Alice Searcy,  
7     insane, at Clarinda State Hospital.

1     Sec. 4. There is hereby appropriated out of the  
2     general fund of the State of Iowa to Grant Shade, Des Moines,  
3     Iowa, the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1000) in full settle-  
4     ment of all claims he may have against the State of Iowa for  
5     personal injuries to eye while an inmate of Ft. Madison State  
6     Penitentiary.

1     Sec. 5. There is hereby appropriated out of the general  
2     fund of the State of Iowa to J. A. Strand and Ruth Anderson  
3     Strand, Dayton, Iowa, the sum of seven hundred fifty dollars  
4     (\$750) in full settlement of all claims which they may have  
5     against the State of Iowa on account of injuries and property  
6     damage and other expense incurred by reason of an accident  
7     with a truck owned by the State of Iowa and operated by an  
8     employee of the State Conservation Commission.

1     Sec. 6. There is hereby appropriated out of the general  
2     fund of the State of Iowa to Tri City Delivery Service,  
3     Davenport, Iowa, the sum of three hundred seventy-one and 23/100  
4     dollars (\$371.23) in full settlement of all claims which it may  
5     have against the State of Iowa for damage to truck and loss

6 of use of truck by reason of accident with State owned jeep.

1 Sec. 7. There is hereby appropriated out of the general  
2 fund of the State of Iowa to Mrs. Clara B. Noble, Des Moines,  
3 Iowa, the sum of thirty-seven and 50/100 dollars (\$37.50) in  
4 full settlement of all claims which she may have against the  
5 State of Iowa on account of a refund of the unexpired portion  
6 of the license fee issued to Nobles Employment Service.

1 Sec. 8. There is hereby appropriated out of the general  
2 fund of the State of Iowa to Muscatine County, Muscatine, Iowa,  
3 the sum of two thousand four hundred seven and 94/100 dollars  
4 (\$2407.94) in full settlement of assessment against State  
5 owned lands in Drainage District Number 13, Muscatine County,  
6 Iowa, taxes payable 1946 and 1947.

1 Sec. 9. There is hereby appropriated out of the general  
2 fund of the State of Iowa to Robert P. Bell, Cedar Rapids,  
3 Iowa, the sum of one hundred twenty-four and 20/100 dollars  
4 (\$124.20) in full settlement of all claims he may have against  
5 the State of Iowa because of an accident with a car owned by  
6 the State of Iowa and operated by the State Commerce Commission.

1 Sec. 10. There is hereby appropriated out of the general  
2 fund of the State of Iowa to Harold W. Miller, Chariton, Iowa,  
3 the sum of four hundred twenty-nine and 85/100 dollars (\$429.85)  
4 in full settlement of all claims he may have against the  
5 State of Iowa because of the death of Ronald LeRoy Miller at  
6 Boys Training School, Eldora, Iowa.

1 Sec. 11. The State Comptroller is hereby authorized to

2 issue warrants to the above named parties in the amounts stated,  
3 and the State Treasurer is hereby directed to pay the same  
4 from the general fund of the State of Iowa.

1 Sec. 12. The acceptance of said amounts by the above  
2 named parties shall be in full settlement of all claims  
3 against the State of Iowa growing out of the above described  
4 claims.
