A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section twenty-four point fourteen (24.14),
Code of Iowa, 1946 relating to the local budget law and
the expenditure of funds thereunder.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. The provisions of this section shall not be
2 applicable to money now on hand or any received by counties
3 prior to and including the thirty-first day of December 1947,
4 or by cities and towns prior to and including the first day of
5 April, 1948, from the one cent gasoline tax provided by section
6 three hundred twenty-four point sixty-three, (324.63), Code
7 of 1946, or out of funds to be received by cities and towns
8 from the sales of liquor as provided by Senate File forty-
9 one, (41), Fifty-second General Assembly, up to and including
10 April 1, 1948, and these funds may be expended by the
11 municipalities for the purposes prescribed by the legislature
12 in the foregoing enactments, prior to said dates. However,
13 all budgets which are hereafter set up in accordance with the
14 statutes in the year 1947 and ensuing years shall take such
15 funds into account, and all such funds, regardless of their
16 source, shall be considered in preparing the budget, all as

17 is provided in Chapter twenty-four, (24), Code of 1946.

1 Sec. 2. This act being deemed of immediate importance
2 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publi-
3 cation in the Reinbeck Courier, a newspaper published in
4 the City of Reinbeck, Iowa and in the Grundy Register, a
5 newspaper published in Grundy Center, Iowa, all without
6 expense to the state.
