# A BILL FOR

An Act to amend chapter one hundred seven (107), Code 1950,  
to provide for participation in the Federal Restoration  
Act.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Chapter one hundred seven (107), Code 1950,  
2 is hereby amended by including the following: "The State of  
3 Iowa hereby assents to the provisions of the Act of Congress  
4 entitled 'An Act to provide that the United States shall  
5 aid the states in fish restoration projects, and for other  
6 purposes', approved August 9, 1950, Public Law 681, and the  
7 State Conservation Commission is hereby authorized and  
8 empowered to perform such acts as may be necessary to the  
9 conduct and establishment of cooperative fish restoration  
10 projects, as defined in said act of congress, in compliance  
11 with said act and with rules and regulations promulgated  
12 by the Secretary of the Interior thereunder; and no funds  
13 accruing to the State of Iowa from license fees paid by  
14 fishermen shall be diverted for any other purposes than as  
15 set out in sections 107.17 and 107.19".

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 60

No money appropriated under the Federal Fish Restoration Act to any State can be expended therein until its legislature has assented to the provisions of the Act and also the state must have a prohibition against the diversions of license fees paid by fishermen for any other purpose than the administration of said state fish and game department. This is the enabling bill which allows Iowa to participate in this Act.
