A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the erection of a memorial to the veterans of the Civil War and to appropriate the sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) to the executive council for such purpose.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. For the purpose of commemorating the service
2 of veterans of the Civil War and in enduring recognition thereof
3 a monument shall be erected upon the capitol grounds. For the
4 accomplishment of such purpose there is hereby appropriated
5 to the executive council the sum of ten thousand dollars
6 (\$10,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary out of
7 any funds of the state treasury not otherwise appropriated.
8 Such monument shall be erected at such place upon such
9 grounds in keeping with the landscaping plan thereof, the
10 character and design of which shall exemplify the intent
11 and purpose of this act.

1 Sec. 2. The council in performance of the duty hereby
2 imposed shall be controlled in the making of any contracts
3 by chapter nineteen (19), Code 1950, insofar as it is
4 applicable.

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 91

This bill is designed to commemorate the service of veterans of the Civil War by authorizing the erection of a monument upon the capitol grounds. The executive council is vested with the duty of carrying out this memorial and the expenditure of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) is appropriated to accomplish this purpose.
