# A BILL FOR

An Act to provide for sanitary control by the department of agriculture, for the cases in which bottled soft drinks are distributed.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Chapter one hundred seventy (170), Code
- 2 1950, is amended by inserting the following new section:
- 3 "The department of agriculture shall require the
- 4 sanitization, by some method approved by the department,
- 5 of all cases, boxes or other containers in which soda pop
- 6 and all other soft drinks are placed for distribution."

### EXPLANATION OF H. F. 104

The purpose of this bill is to provide for sanitary control measures, relating to the cases in which soft drinks are distributed, in the interests of the general public health and welfare.
