A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the change in the name of the profession
of "podiatry" to that of "chiroprody".

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section one hundred forty-six point five
2 (146.5), Code 1950, is amended by striking from line nine
3 (9) the word, "podiatrists" and inserting in lieu thereof the
4 word, "chiroprodists".

1 Sec. 2. Section one hundred fifty point three (150.3),
2 Code 1950, is amended by striking from line five (5) the word,
3 "podiatrists" and inserting in lieu thereof the word,
4 "chiroprodists".

1 Sec. 3. Section one hundred fifty-seven point two
2 (157.2), Code 1950, is amended by striking from line two (2)
3 of subsection one (1) the word, "podiatrists" and inserting in
4 lieu thereof the word, "chiroprodists".

1 Sec. 4. Section one hundred fifty-eight point two
2 (158.2), Code 1950, is amended by striking from line three (3)
3 of subsection one (1) the word, "podiatrists" and inserting
4 in lieu thereof the word, "chiroprodists".

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 168

Chapter 80 of the 53d General Assembly changed the name of the profession of podiatry to "chiroprody" in chapter 149 of the Code. The Act however omitted to make the change in several other chapters where podiatrists were mentioned.
