# A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section six hundred sixty-eight point thirty-three (668.33), Code 1950, relating to the termination of exhausted guardianships.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Section six hundred sixty-eight point
- 2 thirty-three (668.33), Code 1950, is amended by striking
- 3 from line six (6) thereof the words "two hundred" and
- 4 inserting in lieu thereof the words "five hundred".

### EXPLANATION OF H. F. 200

This bill provides that when the property remaining in charge of a guardian of a minor or an incompetent, consisting of personal property only and the value thereof does not exceed \$500, the guardianship may be terminated. It is felt that the expense to the ward in keeping the guardianship open under such circumstances is not justified.
