A BILL FOR

An Act to legalize the action of the board of supervisors of Lyon county in authorizing salary payment to certain deputy county officers.

WHEREAS, section three hundred four point two (304.2), Code 1950, provides that the salary of deputy county officers shall be seventy-five per cent (75%) of the salary of his principal, but not to exceed \$2100.00, and

WHEREAS, the board of supervisors, believing they had power to authorize a salary payment on the basis of \$2100.00, set the salaries of certain deputy county officers, namely; Maesel Albertus, Jo Lois Norris, Arlene Winter Hess, W. B. Dale, Irene Hasche, Gloria Sueverkruebbe and Elinor Rogers, on the basis of \$2100.00 per year, for the years 1948, 1949 and 1950, and

WHEREAS, the question of the legality of such payment was not raised until May 12, 1950, and

WHEREAS, the salaries of said principal officers in Lyon county were \$2700.00 per year, and seventy-five per cent (75%) of said amount would be \$2025.00, and

WHEREAS, in view of recent doubts having been raised as to the legality of said salary payments; now, therefore,

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. The action of the board of supervisors of Lyon
- 2 county, in authorizing salary payments to deputy county
- 3 officers on the basis of \$2100.00 per year for the years
- 4 1948, 1949 and to May 12, 1950 to the following named persons;

5 Maesel Albertus, Jo Lois Norris, Arlene Winter Hess, W. B. Dale,
6 Irene Hasche, Gloria Sueverkruebbe and Elinor Rogers is
7 hereby declared legal, valid and binding.

8 Any deputy county officers who have refunded to the county
9 treasurer such unauthorized payment shall be entitled to have
10 same returned.

11 Sec. 2. This Act being deemed of immediate importance,
12 shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage
13 and publication in the Lyon County Reporter, a
14 newspaper published at Rock Rapids, Iowa, and in
15 the Inwood Herald, a newspaper published at
16 Inwood, Iowa.

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 209

Due to the fact that this money has been paid out to the employees named in said law, it is only fair that they be allowed to keep their salary and that those who have refunded to the treasurer have same returned to them.
