A BILL FOR

An Act to amend chapter five hundred eighty-seven (587), Code 1950, relating to legalizing judgments and decrees.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Chapter five hundred eighty-seven (587), Code
2 1950, is hereby amended as follows:

3 1. Strike from section five hundred eighty-seven point
4 three (587.3), line two (2), the words and figures "January
5 1, 1941" and insert in lieu thereof the words and figures
6 "July 4, 1943".

7 2. Strike from section five hundred eighty-seven point
8 four (587.4), line three (3), the figures: "1941" and insert
9 in lieu thereof the figures: "1951".

10 3. Strike from section five hundred eighty-seven point
11 seven (587.7), line three (3), the figures "1936" and insert
12 in lieu thereof the figures "1946".

13 4. Strike from section five hundred eighty-seven point
14 eight (587.8), line two (2), the figures "1935" and insert
15 in lieu thereof the figures "1945"; strike from line six (6),
16 after the figures "1931" the word "and" and insert in lieu

17 thereof a comma (,); add to line six (6), after the figures
18 and comma "1935," the following words and figures: "1939
19 and rule of civil procedure, number sixty (60), effective
20 July 4, 1943".

21 5. Strike from section five hundred eighty-seven point nine
22 (587.9), line two (2), the figures "1939" and insert in lieu
23 thereof the figures "1949"; strike from line fourteen (14),
24 after the figures "1931" the word "and" and insert in lieu thereof
25 a "comma" (,); add to line fourteen (14), after the figures and
26 comma "1935," the following words and figures: "1939 and rule of
27 civil procedure, number sixty (60), Code 1946".

28 6. Strike from section five hundred eighty-seven point ten
29 (587.10), line five (5), the figures "1940" and insert in lieu
30 thereof the figures "1950".

1 Sec. 2. This Act shall not affect pending litigation nor shall
2 it operate to revive rights or claims previously barred, nor
3 permit an action to be brought or maintained upon any claim or
4 cause of action which is barred by any statute which is in force
5 prior to July 4, 1951, nor shall it affect any action which may be
6 brought on or before January 1, 1952.

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 218

This act was previously passed in 1941 and is now due again. It set ahead the legalizing provisions affecting judgments and decrees.
