A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section three hundred twenty-one point four hundred sixty-six (321.466), Code 1946, relating to increased gross weight registrations.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point four
2 hundred sixty-six (321.466), Code 1950, is amended by inserting
3 following the period (.) in line six (6) the words "Upon a
4 change of ownership an increased gross weight registration may
5 be obtained for any vehicle by payment of one-twelfth of the
6 difference between the annual fee for the higher gross weight
7 and the amount of the fee for the gross weight at which it
8 is registered, multiplied by the number of unexpired months
9 in the year."

1 Section 2. Section three hundred twenty-one point four
2 hundred sixty-six (321.466), Code 1950, is further amended
3 by striking therefrom all of lines seven (7) to sixteen (16)
4 inclusive.

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 239

The purpose of this bill is to make increased weight registration for trucks apply to less than a full year. This will avoid the inequity of payment of overload registration fee for an entire year when the truck has not been used for such loads or has not been owned for said full year.
