## **A BILL FOR**

An Act to legalize and validate the proceedings of the board of directors of the Consolidated School District of Hansell, in the County of Franklin, State of Iowa, authorizing and providing for the issuance and delivery of school building bonds and for the levy of taxes for the payment of said bonds, and declaring the bonds issued pursuant to said proceedings to be enforceable obligations of said school district.

WHEREAS, it appears from the records of the Board of Directors of the Consolidated School District of Hansell, in the County of Franklin, State of Iowa, that at a special election held in and for said school district on the 27th day of April, 1950, the proposition of issuing bonds of said school district in the sum of one hundred thirty thousand dollars (\$130,000) for the purpose of remodeling the present building so as to create two additional grade school rooms, a hot lunch kitchen, dining room, high school assembly, and a library, and to equip all of said rooms, and to build a new building to accommodate vocational agriculture classes, farm shop, band, and to provide a combination auditorium and gymnasium to accommodate school functions, school plays and programs, and athletic contests, and to equip said new building was approved and said proposition was declared carried by more than sixty per cent (60%) of the votes cast at said election; and

WHEREAS, the board of directors of said school district, in reliance upon said election, has by resolutions authorized and provided for the issuance and sale of said school building bonds to the amount and for the purpose aforesaid and in and by said

proceedings has provided for the levy of taxes to pay said bonds and the interest thereon; and

WHEREAS, doubts have arisen concerning the validity and legal sufficiency of said proceedings, election and the provisions made for the issuance and the sale of said bonds on the basis of said election and for the levy and collection of taxes to pay the principal of and the interest on said bonds as the same become due, and it is deemed advisable to put such doubts and all others that might arise concerning same forever at rest; now therefore,

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. That all proceedings heretofore taken by the  
2 board of directors of the Consolidated School District of  
3 Hansell, in the County of Franklin, State of Iowa, preliminary  
4 to and in connection with the special election held in said  
5 school district on the 27th day of April, 1950, and providing  
6 for the issuance, sale and delivery of school building bonds  
7 of said school district to the amount of one hundred thirty  
8 thousand dollars (\$130,000) pursuant to said election and for  
9 the levy of taxes to pay said bonds and interest thereon, are  
10 hereby legalized, validated and confirmed, and said school  
11 building bonds issued and delivered pursuant to and in  
12 accordance with said proceedings are hereby declared to be  
13 legal and to constitute valid and binding obligations of said  
14 school district.

1 Sec. 2. This act being deemed of immediate importance  
2 shall be in force from and after its publication in the  
3 Hampton Chronicle, a newspaper published at Hampton, Iowa,

4 and in the Hampton Times, a newspaper published at Hampton,  
5 Iowa.

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 245
