A BILL FOR

An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary in payment of miscellaneous expenses of the investigating committee created by the House resolution No. 3.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any
2 funds in the general fund of the state of Iowa, not
3 otherwise appropriated, the sum of three thousand dollars
4 (\$3,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary in
5 payment of miscellaneous expenses of the investigating
6 committee created by the House resolution No. 3 which
7 resolution provides for an investigation of the alleged
8 irregularities on the part of the Iowa department of
9 agriculture of the state of Iowa, said committee to report
10 its findings to the Fifty-fourth General Assembly.

1 Sec. 2. The chairman of the committee is authorized to
2 draw vouchers upon the state comptroller for the expenditures

3 herein provided for, and the comptroller is authorized to draw
4 warrants for the same upon the state treasurer.
