A BILL FOR

An Act to amend chapter "two hundred eighty-six A" (286A), Code 1950, relating to general aid to schools, by amending section two hundred eighty-six A point seven (286A.7).

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section two hundred eighty-six A point seven
2 (286A.7) Code 1950, is amended by striking from paragraph one
3 (1) everything beginning with the word "and" in line five (5)
4 of said paragraph.

1 Sec. 2. Section two hundred eighty-six A point seven
2 (286A.7) Code 1950, is further amended by repealing paragraph
3 four (4) of section two hundred eight six A point seven (286A.7)

1 Sec. 3. Section two hundred eighty-six A point seven
2 (286A.7) Code 1950, is further amended by striking from paragraph
3 two (2) of subsection three (3) everything in line four (4)
4 beginning with the word "and" and ending with the word "fund"
5 in line five (5) and by further striking from said paragraph
6 two (2) of subsection (3) everything beginning with the word
7 "The" in line fourteen (14) and ending with the word "purposes"
8 in line nineteen (19).

- 3 paragraph three (3) for subsection three (3).

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 257
