A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section three hundred twenty-one point twenty-one (321.21), Code 1950, relating to registration of motor vehicles and trailers.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point twenty-

2 one (321.21), Code 1950, is hereby amended by striking the period

3 (.) following the word "trailer" in line eleven (11), and adding

4 thereto the following: ", and for such purpose, in counties

5 having a population of forty thousand or more, the county

6 treasurer shall employ a deputy, who shall be paid at the rate

7 of first deputies in the office of county treasurer as provided

8 for in section 340.2."

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 269

In counties having a population of forty thousand or more, there is a need for an extra deputy to handle the registration of motor vehicles and trailers.

This bill is proposed to provide for such deputy and how such deputies are to be paid.
