A BILL FOR

An Act to make permanent a certain temporary transfer of funds of Monroe County, Iowa, made by authority of the state comptroller

WHEREAS, on application of the board of supervisors of Monroe County, Iowa, the state comptroller, on the 6th day of August, 1947, authorized and approved a temporary transfer of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00) from the county bond fund of said county to the county general fund of said county; and

WHEREAS, the county bond fund has sufficient funds to meet all demands thereon and will not require the return of funds temporarily transferred to the county general fund; and

WHEREAS, the county general fund is depleted to such an extent that it would be a hardship to transfer the said twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00) to the county bond fund; therefore

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. The temporary transfer of twenty thousand
2 dollars (\$20,000.00) from the county bond fund of Monroe
3 County, Iowa, to the county general fund of said county
4 approved by the state comptroller on the sixth (6th) day of
5 August, 1947, and duly made, is hereby made a permanent
6 transfer and the same is hereby legalized and made valid.

1 Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,

2 shall take effect and be in full force from and after its
3 passage and publication in the Monroe County News, a
4 newspaper published at Albia, Iowa, and in the
5 Lovilia Press, a newspaper published at Lovilia,
6 Iowa.

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 320

The purpose of this legalizing Act is to make permanent a temporary transfer of a fund in an amount of \$20,000.00 to the county general fund of Monroe County, Iowa. This amount of money is no longer needed in the county bond fund of Monroe County nor will it be needed in that fund in the future.
