A BILL FOR

An Act to amend sections one hundred thirty-five C point one (135C.1), one hundred thirty-five C point two (135C.2) and one hundred thirty-five C point seven (135C.7), Code 1950, relating to nursing homes.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section one hundred thirty-five C point
- 2 one (135C.1), Code 1950, is amended as follows:
- 3 1. By striking from line six (6) the word "two" (2),
- 4 and substituting in lieu thereof the word "one" (1).
- 5 2. By inserting after the comma (,) following the
- 6 words "boarding homes" in line nine (9) the words "boarding
- 7 homes in which old age pensioners are kept or maintained"
- 1 Sec. 2. Section one hundred thirty-five C point two
- 2 (135C.2), Code 1950, line three (3), is amended by inserting
- 3 after the word "home" the following: ", or boarding home in
- 4 which old age pensioners are kept or maintained"
- 1 Sec. 3. Section one hundred thirty-five C point seven
- 2 (135C.7), Code 1950, line three (3), is amended by inserting
- 3 after the word "home" the following: ", or boarding homes in
- 4 which old age pensioners are kept or maintained".

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 321

Under the present law there is no provision controlling boarding houses for old age pensioners. This bill is proposed for the purpose of regulating the housing conditions and facilities for old age pensioners who are kept or maintained in a boarding home.
