A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section one hundred nine point forty-eight
(109.48), Code of 1950, relating to the possession
limit on rabbits.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section one hundred nine point forty-eight
- 2 (109.48) Code of 1950, is hereby amended by adding to the
- 3 table at the end of the section under the heading "Rabbits"
- 4 the following:
- 5 Possession Limit
- 6 "20"

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 328

The law now does not provide for a possession limit on rabbits. The rabbit is Iowa's most important game species and is in need of the additional protection that will be provided by establishing a possession limit.
