## A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section two hundred thirty-one point eight (231.8), Code 1950, relating to salaries of juvenile court probation officers.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Section two hundred thirty-one point  
2 eight (231.8), Code 1950, subsection three (3), is amended  
3 as follows:

4 1. By striking from line five (5) the word "thirty-  
5 six" (36), and by substituting in lieu thereof the word  
6 "forty-one" (41).

7 2. By striking from line eight (8) the word "twelve"  
8 (12), and substituting in lieu thereof the word "fourteen"  
9 (14).

10 3. By striking from line eleven (11) the words  
11 "twenty-five hundred" (2500), and substituting in lieu  
12 thereof the words "three thousand" (3000).

1 Sec. 2. Section two hundred thirty-one point eight  
2 (231.8), Code 1950, subsection four (4), is amended as  
3 follows:

4 1. By striking from line four (4) the word  
5 "forty-two" (42), and substituting in lieu thereof  
6 the word "forty-seven" (47).

7 2. By striking from line eight (8) the word  
8 "twenty-six" (26), and substituting in lieu thereof the  
9 word "twenty-eight" (28).

10 3. By striking from line ten (10) the words  
11 "three thousand" (3000), and substituting in lieu  
12 thereof the words "thirty-five hundred" (3500).

#### EXPLANATION OF H. F. 338

The purpose of this bill is to raise the salaries of the chief probation officer and deputy probation officers, in counties of 50,000 or more, \$500.

Also this bill proposes to raise the amount that may be spent for salaries of \$2,000.
