A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section three hundred twenty-one point four hundred eighty (321.480), Code 1950, relating to expenses of the Highway Commission involved in the weighing and inspection of motor vehicle trailers.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one
2 point four hundred eighty (321.480), Code 1950, is hereby
3 amended by striking from line eight (8) thereof the words
4 "eighty-three" and inserting in lieu thereof the words
5 "two hundred fifty".

1 Sec. 2. This act being deemed of immediate
2 importance shall be in full force and effect upon its
3 passage and publication in the Lake View Resort
4 a newspaper published at Lake View, Iowa, and
5 in the Grinnell Herald-Register, a newspaper published at
6 Grinnell, Iowa.

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 408

The section which is amended provides that there may be expended from the primary road fund for the purpose of administering the weighing provisions a sum not to exceed \$83,000 per year, due to the large increase in truck traffic. More weighing facilities are needed and more personnel are required in order to obtain adequate enforcement than can be provided under the limitation. This bill raises the limitation to \$250,000 per year.
