## A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section one hundred twenty-four point thirty-nine (124.39), Code 1950, relating to the booths and windows of establishments where beer is sold under a class "B" license.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Section one hundred twenty-four point  
2 thirty-nine (124.39), Code 1950, sub-section three (3),  
3 is hereby stricken and repealed and the following enacted  
4 in lieu thereof: "No booths shall be allowed in any room  
5 where beer is sold under a class "B" license after January  
6 1, 1952."

1 Sec. 2. A new section is hereby added to section  
2 one hundred twenty-four point thirty-nine (124.39), Code  
3 1950, as follows: "Sub-section five (5): There shall be  
4 no curtains or opaque or other than clear glass in all  
5 windows in any room in which beer is sold under a class  
6 "B" license and all such rooms shall be so equipped with  
7 windows as to permit clear and unobstructed view of the  
8 major portions of said rooms from a distance of fifty  
9 (50) feet above sidewalk level."

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 513

This bill is a regulatory measure for the control of law enforcement where beer is sold.
