## A BILL FOR

An Act prohibiting the installation or equipment connected therewith of any television set, or any device designed for video reception, and for amending Chapter three hundred twenty-one (321), Code 1950.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Chapter three hundred twenty-one (321), Code  
2 1950, be and is hereby amended by adding thereto the  
3 following:

4 "No television set or other device designed for video  
5 reception, or any equipment connected therewith, shall be  
6 installed or maintained in any motor vehicle operating upon  
7 the highways of this state."

1 Sec. 2. Chapter three hundred twenty-one (321), Code  
2 1950, be and is hereby further amended by adding thereto the  
3 following:

4 "No person shall operate upon the highways of this state  
5 any motor vehicle containing any television set, or other  
6 device designed for video reception."

1 Sec. 3. This Act being deemed of immediate importance

2 shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication  
3 in the ....., a newspaper published at .....,  
4 Iowa, and in the ....., a newspaper published at  
5 ....., Iowa.
