A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section three hundred twenty-one point two hundred forty-nine (321.249), Code 1950, relating to the establishment of school zones.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point two
2 hundred forty-nine (321.249), Code 1950, is hereby amended by
3 striking all of said section and substituting in lieu thereof
4 the following:

5 "Cities, towns and counties shall have the power to
6 establish school zones within their respective jurisdiction;
7 when movable stop signs have been placed in the streets in such
8 cities and towns and on the highways in such counties at the
9 limits of such zones, the driver of any vehicle on such streets
10 or highways shall bring said vehicle to a complete stop at such
11 stop signs before entering said school zone; this notwithstanding
12 the provisions of any statute to the contrary.

13 "It shall be a misdemeanor punishable as provided in
14 section 321.482, for any person operating a vehicle to fail to
15 bring such vehicle to a complete stop as herein provided."

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 536

This bill seeks to make more workable and understandable the present provisions of Section 321.249, Code 1950. It also makes it a criminal offense on the part of the driver of a vehicle who fails to bring his vehicle to a complete stop at school stop signs lawfully erected within a school zone.
