A BILL FOR

An Act to amend chapters two hundred sixty-three (263)
and two hundred sixty-six (266), Code 1950, by
providing for athletic contest between the state
university and the state college at Ames, Iowa.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Chapter two hundred sixty-three (263),
2 Code 1950, is hereby amended by adding thereto the
3 following new section:

4 "The athletic director of the state university,
5 under the supervision of the state board of education,
6 shall schedule one (1) athletic contest each school
7 term in football, basketball and baseball, in the
8 respective season of each named sport."

1 Sec. 2. Chapter two hundred sixty-six (266),
2 Code 1950, is hereby amended by adding thereto the
3 following new section:

4 "The athletic director of Iowa state college, under
5 the supervision of the state board of education, shall
6 schedule one (1) athletic contest each school term in

7 football, basketball and baseball, in the respective

8 season of each named sport.”

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 561

Athletic contest between the state university and Iowa state college always creates a lot of interest. There are many graduates of each institution who would like to see the athletic relations of the two institutions continued.

This bill provides that these two institutions shall meet in the three major athletic sports once each school term.
