A BILL FOR

An Act creating a legislative advisory committee to carry out the provisions of chapter three hundred seven (307), Acts of the Fifty-second General Assembly, chapter sixteen (16), Acts of the Forty-ninth General Assembly, chapter ten (10), Acts of the Fifty-first General Assembly, and chapter seventeen (17), Acts of the Fifty-third General Assembly, relating to the construction of the state office building.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter
2 nineteen (19), Acts of the 50th General Assembly, there shall
3 be created a Legislative Advisory Committee consisting of
4 three members of the Senate and three members of the House
5 of Representatives to be appointed by the respective
6 presiding officers of the Senate and House, for the purpose
7 of carrying out the legislative intent of this act and of
8 chapter sixteen (16), Acts of the 49th General Assembly,
9 chapter ten (10), Acts of the 51st General Assembly, chapter
10 three hundred seven (307), Acts of the 52nd General Assembly,
11 and chapter seventeen (17), Acts of the 53rd General Assembly.

1 Sec. 2. The term of the Legislative Advisory Committee

2 small terminate upon the convening of the Fifty-fifth (55)
3 General Assembly. Any vacancy occurring on the Legislative
4 Advisory Committee shall be filled by the presiding officer
5 of the House in the event the vacancy occurs in the
6 membership of said committee from the House of Representatives,
7 and by the Lieutenant Governor, in the event the vacancy
8 occurs in the membership of said committee from the Senate.

9 In carrying out the provisions of this Act, chapter
10 seventeen (17), Acts of the 53rd General Assembly, chapter
11 three hundred seven (307) in the 52nd General Assembly,
12 chapter sixteen (16) in the 49th General Assembly, and chapter
13 ten (10) of the 51st General Assembly, the Executive Council
14 of the State of Iowa and the Legislative Advisory Committee
15 shall meet jointly at such places as may be determined by
16 the Executive Council, and in determining all matters coming
17 before said meeting it shall require a majority vote of the
18 members of the joint committee of the Executive Council and
19 of the Legislative Advisory Committee.

20 The Legislative Advisory Committee shall meet and
21 organize immediately following sine die adjournment of the
22 Fifty-fourth General Assembly, and at the same time and
23 immediately following its organization, meet with the
24 Executive Council in order that the committee and council
25 may advise on carrying out the provision of this Act, and
26 the provisions of chapter seventeen (17) of the 53rd General
27 Assembly, chapter three hundred seven (307) of the 52nd

28 General Assembly, chapter ten (10) of the 51st General
29 Assembly and chapter sixteen (16), Acts of the 49th General
30 Assembly.

1 Sec. 3. Each member of the Legislative Advisory
2 Committee shall be entitled to actual necessary hotel and
3 traveling expenses incurred in the discharge of his duties,
4 upon an itemized certification of the amounts due, filed
5 with the comptroller for audit, and in payment thereof the
6 comptroller shall issue warrants on the state office building
7 fund, from which a sufficient amount is hereby set aside
8 for this purpose. In addition, each member of such
9 Legislative Advisory Committee shall receive such compensation
10 for time spent, in the discharge of his duties as may be
11 allowed by the General Assembly next convening.

1 Sec. 4. Insofar as chapter nineteen (19), Acts of the
2 50th General Assembly is in conflict with this Act, the same
3 is hereby repealed.

1 Sec. 5. This act being deemed of immediate importance
2 shall be in full force and effect from and after its
3 publication in The Guttenberg Press, a newspaper published
4 at Guttenberg, Iowa, and in the Daily Times, a newspaper
5 published at Davenport, Iowa.

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 590

This bill provides for the setting up of a legislative advisory committee, in connection with the state office building, to serve during the interim following adjournment of the Fifty-fourth General Assembly. This committee is merely a continuation of former similar committees to advise with the executive council on matters pertaining to the new state office building.
