A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the training and licensing of boys in the state training school to practice barbering.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Chapter two hundred forty-two (242), Code
2 1950, is amended by adding thereto the following:
3 "The boys training school at Eldora may conduct a school
4 of barbering within the institution and it shall be unnecessary
5 for such school to comply with the provisions of sections one
6 hundred fifty-eight point three (158.3) and one hundred fifty-
7 eight point four (158.4) of the Code. Graduates of such school
8 after passing an examination conducted by the superintendent
9 shall, upon certification by the superintendent, be issued a
10 regular certificate to practice by the state department of
11 health. Said certificate shall differ in no respect from any
12 other certificate issued to practitioners of barbering by the
13 department. No more than twelve graduates of such school shall
14 be licensed to practice in any one year.

EXPLANATION OF H. F. 596

This bill would permit the boys training school at Eldora, Iowa, to establish a barbering school so that the boys committed thereto could be taught a useful and remunerative occupation which would do much to rehabilitate them so that they may take their places as worthy members of society.
