A BILL FOR

An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa for the biennium beginning July 1, 1951, and ending June 30, 1953, to the state fair board for the purpose of state aid to agricultural societies.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. For the state fair board for the purpose
2 of state aid to agricultural societies there is hereby
3 appropriated from the general fund of the state for each
4 year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1951, and ending
5 June 30, 1953, the sum of one hundred seventy-five thousand
6 dollars (\$175,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary
7 to be used in the following manner:

8 For state aid to agricultural societies, one hundred
9 seventy-five thousand dollars (\$175,000.00).

10 The foregoing appropriation for state aid to agricultural
11 societies shall be deemed conditional on full compliance with
12 all other statutes which regulate and prescribe the conditions
13 under which such aid is payable. In no case shall any county
14 receive more than two thousand two hundred dollars (\$2,200.00).
15 In counties having more than one fair entitled to state aid,

- 16 the state aid available for the county shall be prorated to
- 17 said fairs on the basis of cash premiums paid by said fairs.
