A BILL FOR

An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state of Iowa for the biennium beginning July 1, 1951, and ending June 30, 1953, to the social welfare department for the purpose of aid to blind fund, aid to dependent children fund, child welfare fund, emergency relief fund and the old age assistance fund.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. For the social welfare department there is
2 hereby appropriated from the general fund of the state for
3 each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1951, and ending
4 June 30, 1953, the sum of seven million two hundred ten
5 thousand dollars (\$7,210,000.00) to be used in the following
6 manner:

7	For aid to blind fund.....	\$ 275,000.00
8	For aid to dependent children fund.....	2,175,000.00
9	For child welfare fund.....	220,000.00
10	For emergency relief fund.....	40,000.00

11 For old age assistance fund (in addition
12 to ten million dollars (\$10,000,000.00),
13 appropriated for this purpose by section two
14 hundred forty-nine point thirty-six (249.36),

15 Code 1950 4,500,000.00

16 Grand total of all appropriations for all
17 purposes for each year of the biennium for
18 the social welfare department.....\$7,210,000.00

1 Sec. 2. No more than the amount herein appropriated to
2 each fund, plus the unexpended balance in each fund on June
3 30, 1951, shall be expended from state funds for the purposes
4 of each said fund during the biennium beginning July 1, 1951,
5 and ending June 30, 1953.
