HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Iowa relating to the manner of amending said constitution.

Be It Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Article ten (X) of the Constitution of the
2 State of Iowa is amended by inserting therein the following
3 new section:

4 "On petition of fifteen per cent of the total number of
5 voters in the last preceding election for Governor of the State,
6 to the Secretary of State, proposing an amendment to the
7 Constitution, such proposed amendment shall be submitted to
8 the people at the next general election; and if the people shall
9 approve and ratify such amendment, by a majority of the electors
10 qualified to vote for members of the General Assembly, voting
11 thereon, such amendment or amendments shall become a part of
12 the Constitution of this State."

1 Sec. 2. This amendment, if approved by the Fifty-fifth
2 General Assembly of Iowa and adopted by the electors of this
3 State, shall apply to the mode of amending the Constitution

4 of this State as set forth in Article ten (X) of the Constitution
5 of the State of Iowa.

1 Sec. 3. That the foregoing proposed amendment be and
2 the same is hereby referred to the General Assembly to be
3 chosen at the next general election for members of the General
4 Assembly, and that the Secretary of State cause the same to be
5 published for three months previous to the date of said
6 election, as provided by law.
