# HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the state of Iowa relating to the limitation on use of funds derived from motor vehicle registration fees and all licenses and excise taxes on motor vehicle fuel.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Amend Article seven (VII), section eight (8)  
2 of the Constitution of the state of Iowa by adding thereto  
3 the following:  
4 "The term 'motor vehicle' as used in this section shall  
5 not mean nor include any contrivance used or designed for  
6 navigation of or flight in the air. All aircraft registration  
7 fees and licenses and excise taxes upon any fluid or other  
8 means or instrumentalities used in producing or generating  
9 power for propelling aircraft shall be used exclusively for  
10 the construction, improvement, maintenance and operation of  
11 landing areas for aircraft, the enforcement and administration  
12 of the laws of the state relative to aeronautics and the  
13 establishment, housing, equipping, staffing, operating and  
14 maintaining of agencies of the state functioning solely for  
15 the purposes of encouraging, fostering and assisting in the

16 general development and promotion of aeronautics and the  
17 enforcement and administration of the aeronautical laws of the  
18 state.”

1     Sec. 2. That the foregoing proposed amendment be, and  
2 the same is hereby referred to the General Assembly to be  
3 chosen at the next general election for members of the General  
4 Assembly and that the secretary of state cause the same to be  
5 published for three (3) months previous to the date of said  
6 election, as provided by law.
