A BILL FOR

An Act to provide for the care and control of trees, shrubbery, flowers and grass upon the parking along streets and driveways in certain cities under the manager plan by election, and to amend chapter four hundred nineteen (419), Code 1950.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Chapter four hundred nineteen (419),
2 Code 1950, is amended by adding the following:
3 "Cities having a population of twenty-five thousand
4 or more shall have power by ordinance to take and assume
5 charge, custody, and control of all trees, shrubbery,
6 flowers, and grass outside of the lot or property lines
7 and inside the curb lines and upon the public streets
8 and driveways in such manner as not to interfere with
9 public travel, and to levy in addition to all other taxes
10 annually upon all taxable property therein a tax of not
11 more than one-half of a mill on the dollar for the purpose
12 of planting, caring for, removing, and maintaining of said
13 trees, shrubs, flowers, and grass. Such cities may provide
14 by ordinance for assessing the cost or any part thereof

15 upon the lots or parcels of land in front of which trees,
16 shrubbery, flowers, or grass are planted and maintained.
17 The carrying into effect of the provisions of any
18 ordinance enacted hereunder shall be vested in the
19 board of park commissioners.”
