## A BILL FOR

An Act transferring any unallocated balance of appropriation made by chapter two (2), Acts of the Forty-eighth General Assembly to the state board of control, and any unallocated balance of appropriation made to the state board of control by chapter three (3), Acts of the Forty-ninth General Assembly, to the capitol improvement fund created by chapter three (3), Acts of the Fifty-first General Assembly.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. On the effective date of this act there shall  
2 be transferred the balance of any fund appropriated to the state  
3 board of control by chapter two (2), Acts of the Forty-eighth  
4 General Assembly; to the fund created and established by chapter  
5 three (3), Acts of the Fifty-first General Assembly. This  
6 balance, when transferred, shall be used for the same institution  
7 as designated by the foregoing chapter two (2), Acts of the  
8 Forty-eighth General Assembly.

1 Sec. 2. On the effective date of this act there shall be  
2 transferred the balance of any fund appropriated to the state  
3 board of control by chapter three (3), Acts of the Forty-ninth  
4 General Assembly, to the fund created and established by chapter  
5 three (3), Acts of the Fifty-first General Assembly. This

6 balance, when transferred, shall be used for the same institution  
7 as designated by the foregoing chapter three (3), Acts of the  
8 Forty-ninth General Assembly.

1 Sec. 3. The balance of the foregoing appropriated funds  
2 directed herein to be transferred shall be such funds remaining  
3 from the appropriations made by chapter two (2), Acts of the  
4 Forty-eighth General Assembly and chapter three (3), Acts of  
5 the Forty-ninth General Assembly, excluding therefrom the  
6 expenditures which do not at the effective date of this act  
7 bear the express approval of the executive council and the  
8 joint legislative committee on retrenchment and reform.

1 Sec. 4. The comptroller is hereby directed to make the  
2 transfer on the books in his office and to certify to the  
3 treasurer of the state the fact that the transfers herein  
4 directed have been made and have been so entered upon the  
5 books in his office.

1 Sec. 5. This act being deemed of immediate importance,  
2 shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage
