A BILL FOR

An Act providing for an appropriation to the service compensation fund existing under Section 35A.3, Code 1950, for the purpose of paying unpaid claims to veterans of World War II and the expenses of administration of the Service Compensation Board.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the
2 general fund of the state from funds not otherwise appropriated
3 the sum of eight million dollars (\$8,000,000), or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of
5 Section two (2) of this act, to the service compensation
6 fund provided for by Section 35A.3 of the Code of 1950.

1 Sec. 2. The sum herein appropriated shall be used for the
2 purpose of paying claims filed with the World War II Service
3 Compensation Board on or before December 31, 1950, which have
4 been, or might hereafter be, allowed by that board and to pay
5 the expenses of the administration of that board in carrying
6 out its duties as prescribed by the provisions of Chapter 35A
7 of the Code of 1950.

1 Sec. 3. This act being deemed of immediate importance

2 shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage
3 and publication in the Reinbeck Courier, a newspaper published
4 at Reinbeck, Iowa, and the Red Oak Express newspaper published
5 at Red Oak, Iowa.
