## A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section three hundred twenty-one point three hundred forty-two (321.342), Code 1950, relating to railroads erecting and maintaining appropriate signs at all of their highway grade crossings outside cities and towns.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point three  
2 hundred forty-two (321.342), Code 1950, is hereby amended by  
3 striking all of said section and inserting in lieu thereof the  
4 following:  
5 "Railroads shall erect, place and maintain at all of their  
6 highway grade crossings, outside cities and towns, appropriate  
7 signs to provide for the stopping of all vehicles approaching  
8 such crossings. Such signs shall conform to the sign manual  
9 adopted by the state highway commission. When such stop signs  
10 are erected the driver of any vehicle shall stop within fifty  
11 feet but not less than ten feet from the nearest track of such  
12 grade crossing and shall proceed only upon exercising due care."
